

## University of Pittsburgh Career Center Alumni Policy

1. Undergraduate and Graduate Alumni
  - a. Work with all undergraduate alumni except College of Business, School of Public Health, and School of Public and International Affairs
  - b. Work with graduate alumni from Dietrich Arts & Sciences, Swanson School of Engineering, School of Computing and Information, School of Health and Rehab Science, College of General Studies, School of Education, School of Nursing
  - c. All online resources available to all alumni regardless of school/college\*
  
2. Non-Graduates/Unfinished Degrees
  - a. From Alumni Association
    - i. 30+ credit hours with unfinished degree is labeled an Alumnus without a Degree
    - ii. Less than 30 credit hours receives no designation
  - b. Career Center Policy
    - i. Work with undergraduates and graduates with unfinished degrees for 6 months after they ended their Pitt studies regardless of credit hours earned
    - ii. No additional services or resources after the 6 months
    - iii. All website resources (including Handshake) available\*
    - iv. If a non-graduate reaches out to the Career Center after the 6 months they will be given one appointment with the Alumni Career Consultant to review policies and resources.
  
3. Regional Campus Alumni
  - a. Regional campus alumni must work with their respective Career Services office but we will provide one zoom appointment to review and discuss all of the resources available from the Career Center.
  - b. All online resources available to all alumni from regional campuses\*
